Work that was not part of the project requiring a Soil Erosion Sedimentation Control (SESC) permit (i.e. tree trimming) has commenced. Once the SESC permit is received, the remaining construction will commence. Contiguous property owners have been notified of the construction time-line. We are still raising funds for playground equipment.
